

The plan of the graveyard is provided only to show the relative positions of the graves and is NOT to scale.

The numbers in this list refer to graves with the corresponding numbers on the plan. There are several gaps in the sequence 1-365 to allow for the insertion of information that may come to light from other sources. In some cases, a grave numbered on the plan has no entry in the list. This may be because the headstone has been broken or because the inscription is no longer legible or for some other reason.
